


Who should people at church tell other people about?




Color the shapes with dots one color and the shapes without a dot another color to reveal the special name.

The Church Told About Jesus

BASED ON ACTS 4:1-20

WEEKLY VERSE: We must tell what we have seen and heard about Jesus. *Acts 4:20*

LIFE POINT: People at church tell other people about Jesus.



One day Peter and John helped a man who could not walk to be able to walk. They told the people who saw this about Jesus. Some of the leaders did not like what Peter and John were saying. They had Peter and John put into jail, but that did not stop many people from hearing and believing in Jesus that day.
